- a. Each day of the 15<sup>th</sup> annual Tour de Murrieta bike race will host a challenging type of race. The ever-popular, fast-paced, one-mile Grand Prix will take place on Saturday, March 7 with races beginning at 7:30 a.m. and the under 12 kids' race beginning at 12 noon. The start/finish line is on Juniper Street in front of the Senior Center at 5 Town Square.
