- a. The City's **Alternative Recreation Program** offers activities for special needs adults 18 years and older at least once each month. The program fee is \$2 per participant with guardians and caregivers free. Activities take place at the Senior Center. - b. The upcoming **Military Moms and Wives Bruncheon** is a FREE event set for Saturday, May 11 from 9 a.m. until 11 a.m. at the Murrieta Library's Garden of Verses. On-site childcare for ages 3 to 12 years is provided by the CSD staff. See attachment 9b.
- c. On Wednesday, May 15, the Senior Center will host its annual **Ladies Day Tea** from 1 to 3 p.m. For this event, the senior center ladies don their most springtime apparel and bonnets to enjoy an afternoon of finger sandwiches, crudités, tea, and sweets. On Saturday, May 18 from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m., the CSD is hosting an open forum meeting for the residents in the Mapleton tract to gain input on the design and installation of an **R/C (remote control) race track** in the unused area of the volleyball court at Mapleton Park. Residents will get a chance to find out all about R/C racing, the tract design, and they will even be able to get hands-on training with demos taking place in the parking lot. This open forum meeting will allow staff the opportunity to answer questions and obtain feedback relating to the course and course construction. Staff from the City, business hobby stores, MVUSD STEM Club, and R/C enthusiasts will all be on hand to answer the public's questions and mitigate any concerns they might have relating to noise, construction, costs, etc.
