9. **INFORMATION ITEMS**

- a. The Murrieta’s Youth Center is proud to launch its 2021 Virtual Youth Art Showcase on Friday, May 21. Murrieta’s own local amateur artists from 10 to 18 years will be able to show off their creations. The event is open to both groups and individuals and submissions will be displayed on the Youth Center’s Instagram story (@murrietayouthcenter) as well as in a virtual gallery. The art categories include any visual art format including painting, drawing, photography, fashion, as well as clay, sculpture, nouveau, etc. Participation is FREE to the Art Showcase. The deadline for submissions is May 17, 2021.
- b. The City’s Memorial Day observance will take place near the Fallen Warriors Monument at Town Square Park on Monday, May 31, 2021 beginning at 8 a.m. We will honor and pay tribute to those service persons who have selflessly laid down their lives defending our freedoms. This is a FREE event for the public to attend.
- c. Ribbon cutting events – *tentative dates*: Towns Square Amphitheater, Wednesday June 2 by invitation and Mapleton R/C Track, Saturday, June 12, 2021. Additional information to follow as the dates draw near.
- d. If the COVID numbers continue their downward trend, the Tour de Murrieta will be able to take place June 5 and June 6, 2021. The event organizers will forgo the kids’ race and instead offer a bike safety course with pre-registration. The start/finish line will be on Juniper Street in front of the Senior Center. The ever-popular, fast-paced, one-mile Grand Prix will take place on Saturday, June 5 with races beginning at 7:30 a.m. The rolling, 4-mile Circuit Race with its eight turns will take place Sunday, June 6 beginning at 7:30 a.m. and is expected to conclude around 4:30 p.m. There is no charge for spectators to view the races.
- e. The CSD will host a ‘Cruise n’ Tunes’ event the Saturday before Father’s Day on June 19. The first 100, pre-1980 or specialty vehicles will cruise the city on a pre-designated route beginning at 5 p.m. starting from Town Square. Then the cruisers can return to Town Square Park and enjoy some cool tunes at the amphitheater. The concert portion will start around 5:30 p.m. Registration is \$20 per vehicle and includes a commemorative 50th anniversary t-shirt.
- f. Commemorative 30th anniversary fireworks display launched from Heritage Hill at 9 p.m. on July 1, 2021.
