DISCUSSION ITEMS

D1. General Plan Update

Jeff Hitch, Principal Civil Engineer introduced the item and provided the report. Mr. Hitch indicated that the City initiated a focused update to the City's General Plan, Climate Action Plan, and a supplemental Environmental Impact report. The City's existing General Plan was adopted in 2011 and provides a vision for the development of the City through 2035.

Commissioner discussion ensued.

Action: Received and filed the General Plan Update.

D2. Los Alamos Road Resident Concerns

Jeff Hitch, Principal Civil Engineer, introduced the item and provided the report. Mr. Hitch provided that at the April 17 Traffic Commission meeting, 5 residents spoke during the public comment portion of the meeting in regards to the recently increased posted speed limit of 45 mph. The previous speed limit was 40 mph. Staff subsequently reviewed the concerns that were brought up at the meeting, and the results are presented in the staff report.

Commissioner discussion ensued.

Public Comments:

Alan Long, Murrieta resident, asked about landscaping agreements between the City and Caltrans.

Action: It was moved by Commissioner Warren, seconded by Commissioner Chandler for approval to:

- Install 30 mph curve warning signage at 2 locations on Los Alamos Road north of Perry Road.
- Install 35 mph curve warning signage at 1 location on Los Alamos Road at Crawford Canyon Road
- Install raised pavement markers on top of double yellow stripe at 5 locations around curves on Los Alamos Road.
- Install all way stop at Los Alamos Road and Perry Road as amended for staff to look into supplementing with LED lighting
- Trim shrubbery at Los Alamos Road and Mason Avenue, to maximize available sight distance.

D3. Masters Drive Resident Concerns

Aida Eddington, Consulting Traffic Engineer, introduced the item and provided the report. On January 18, 2019, the City received a petition from residents along Masters Drive to install traffic calming measures that consist of signs, striping, speed display trailers or speed humps to address speeding concerns along Masters Drive between Members Club Drive and Couples Avenue. In November 2014, City Council authorized the installation of speed humps within the Rancho California Golf Club

Neighborhoods due to increasing demands from residents for adequate traffic calming measures to address concerns of speeding, heavy volume, and cut through traffic.

Commissioner discussion ensued. Chairperson Barton provided the public with a brief overview of the City Council's policy regarding speed humps.
