REGISTRATION

Registration will be held on **Saturday August 10th from 9-11a.m. FOR RESIDENT TEAMS ONLY.** On **Monday August 12th Registration** will be open for **ALL** teams from **9a.m.-5p.m.**

All teams interested in participating in the current season must submit, in person, all the items listed on the checklist to the **League Offices at the Murrieta Youth Center** during the appropriate registration dates. **ONLY COMPLETED PACKETS WITH THE CORRECT CORRESPONDING FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED. IF YOUR PACKET IS INCOMPLETE, IT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THAT TIME. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

Registration procedures will be as follows:

The first day of registration is open to **Murrieta Resident Teams Only. Resident** teams registering on **Saturday** will essentially be able to sign-up for **any** league just as long as it is not already occupied by **ALL Resident** teams. All registrations made on the following Monday will be on a first come first serve basis to fill any open spots. There is no priority to returning teams.

***A resident team's roster will consist of at least 80% Murrieta Residents. Resident teams must maintain 80% residency throughout the season.**

Teams that fall below the 80% residency rate will not be eligible for playoffs and will not be allowed to register as a resident team for one year. Resident teams not registering during the first week of registration will not receive priority over non-resident teams. Every effort will be made to ensure teams are in the appropriate league based on their past records to provide the highest quality of league parity possible. If you are unsure of which league your teams should register for, please call the league director prior to registering.

LEAGUE PLAY

Although most leagues consist of 6 teams and 10 games, teams are guaranteed 9 games during the regular season. All games will be conducted under S.C.M.A.F. rules and Murrieta Supplemental rules; rules will be available on the Adult Softball page of the city's website. Games are played at Cal Oaks Sports Park on Softball Field #1.

Wednesday Coed "Rec" 6:30, 7:45 & 9:00 p.m.

Thursday Men's "Rec" 6:30, 7:45 & 9:00 p.m.

Sunday Coed "Rec" 2:15, 3:30, 4:45 & 6:00pm

"Rec" leagues are open to teams of all caliber of play.

Games start the week of August 27th, 2019.

Due to the rising concern of player safety regarding the use of illegal bats; the City requires all teams to use league issued bats. The bats that will be provided for each team to use will range in weight and model.

LEAGUE FEES

Tuesday – Friday Leagues \$425.00

Each Non-resident Player \$ 10.00

All fees are due at the time of registration along with all the checklist items below

- A completed original roster signed by all players. For designated season.
- A completed player code of conduct form signed by the Manager and initialed by each player.
- A visible copy of a valid photo I.D. of each player and proof of residency for all Murrieta Residents (i.e. a copy of a Utility Bill or other official correspondence showing the players name and address. P.O. Boxes are not proof of Residency).

All league fees must accompany the above listed information in order to have a completed packet. Cash, Checks, money orders or any major credit cards are accepted. Please submit only one Form of Payment for League Fees unless a Sponsor is paying your team's league fees, then you may submit two different payments, one for your league fees and another for your Non-resident fees.

Late Fee: Any teams, who turn in their paperwork and league fees after August 12th, 2019, will be charged an additional \$50 late fee. This season will be full, please come prepared with all your info and fees. ALL players must submit a copy of ID; Murrieta residents must also submit new proof of residency.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYER SHALL: At any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike or threaten an official. Officials are required to immediately suspend a player from further play and report such players to the League Director. The player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from All Parks and Recreation Leagues for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for life and/or assault charges filed.

PLAYER SHALL: Refuse to abide by an official's decision. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such a player to the League Director. The player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from two league games, placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at an official's decisions.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Warning of the official.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from "x number" of league games, and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Discuss with an official in any manner the decisions reached by an official, except the manager/coach of the team.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Warning by the official.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from "x number" of league games, and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against the body and person of an opposing player. Officials are required to immediately suspend a player from further play and report such players to the League Director. Such a player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from two league games and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official, or spectator. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further and report such players to the League Director. The player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from ALL Parks and Recreation Leagues for a one year period.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for life and/or assault charges filed.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of abusive verbal attack upon a player, official or spectator. Officials are required immediately suspend the player from further play and report such players to the League Director. The player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from "x number" of league games, and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Appear upon the playing facility (the parking lot included) at any time in an intoxicated condition officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such players to the League Director. The player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for two league games and placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension for the remainder of the season.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of gambling upon any play or the outcome of games with any spectator, player, or opponent. Officials are required to report violation of this to the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Placed on probation for the remainder of the season.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Removal from the game by the official.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Smoke while coming on or off the playing area or while on the field of play.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Warning by the official.

MAXIMUM PEANLTY: Removal from the game by the official.

NO PLAYER SHALL: Possess any alcoholic beverage upon the playing facility (including the parking lot) at any time. Officials are required to report violation of this to the League Director.

MINIMUM PENALTY: Warning by official.

MAXIMUM PENALTY: Suspension from the league for the remainder of the season.

SPECIAL NOTE: Any player being placed on probation for the remainder of the season is then reported again for violating any "Code of Conduct" will be suspended for the remainder of the season.

- a. Any player removed from a game must leave the facility immediately. Failure to do so will carry a maximum penalty or suspension for the remainder of the season.

"Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement"

Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to reserve (facility) on the above listed date(s) and time(s), I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue The City of Murrieta, its officers, employees, and agents from liability from any/all claims including the negligence of the City of Murrieta, its officers, employees and agents, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in this event.

Assumption of Risks: Participation in this event carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains 2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks and concussions to 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

I have read the previous paragraphs and I know, understand, and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in this event and I hereby assert that my participation is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all such risks.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: I also agree to INDEMNIFY and HOLD the City of Murrieta HARMLESS from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in this activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred. I hereby acknowledge that as a voluntary participant that I am not an employee of the City of Murrieta and that I am not covered under the City's workers' compensation plan. I intend to perform voluntary services for or in the City of Murrieta without compensation. As a condition of performing the above referenced volunteer activities, I hereby knowingly and unequivocally waive, release and discharge any and all rights that I, my heirs, assigns, agents or other representatives may have or which hereafter may accrue to me, to file any claim, lawsuit and/or any other cause of action against the City of Murrieta, its employees, officers, agencies, other volunteers and officials as a result of performing said volunteer services. In granting this full and complete release and waiver of liability on the part of the City of Murrieta, I specifically waive California Civil Code Section 1542, which states:

A general release does not extend to claims, which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him, must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.

I expressly desire to release the City of Murrieta, its employees, officers, other volunteers, property owner, and officials from any financial responsibility to me for any personal injury and/or property damage I may incur as a result of my voluntary participation, even when it results from the negligence, both active and passive, of the City of Murrieta and/or its employees. I understand that accidents and injuries can arise out of my volunteer activities; knowing the risk, nevertheless, I hereby agree to assume those risks and to release and to hold harmless the City of Murrieta, its employees, officers, agencies, other volunteers and officials, who (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs, assigns, agents or other representatives) for damages. No promise, inducement, or agreement has been made to me to induce me to release the City of Murrieta from liability for any personal injury and/or property damage incurred by me as a result of my voluntary participation, nor has any promise, inducement, or agreement been made to me in return for the express waiver of rights referred to above.

Severability: The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledgement of Understanding: I have read this waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue. I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily, and intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.
