COVID-19 Relief: Murrieta to Defer Business License Renewal Fees

To support local businesses as they navigate the impact of COVID-19, the City of Murrieta is deferring business-license renewal fees for 90 days, through June 30, 2020.

Deputy Director for Development Services Scott Agajanian cites the importance of working collaboratively to help local businesses, many of which are struggling with closures or changes in day-to-day operations.

“With an ever-changing landscape of local, state and federal government support for business; we’re monitoring gaps, opportunities and mandates as we work together to help Murrieta business through these challenging times. We know our businesses are hurting, and we are in this together.”

When the deferral period ends, business license fees will be due and payable without penalties or interest.
