At which the City Council will receive public input on redistricting boundaries and adopt an ordinance adopting new district boundaries.

If you challenge the City's action on this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to the public hearing.

The proposed ordinance adopting new district boundaries will be available for public inspection at the City Clerk's Office (City Hall, 1 Town Square, Murrieta), during normal business hours or on the City's Clerk's Redistricting webpage www.murrietaca.gov/redistricting.
