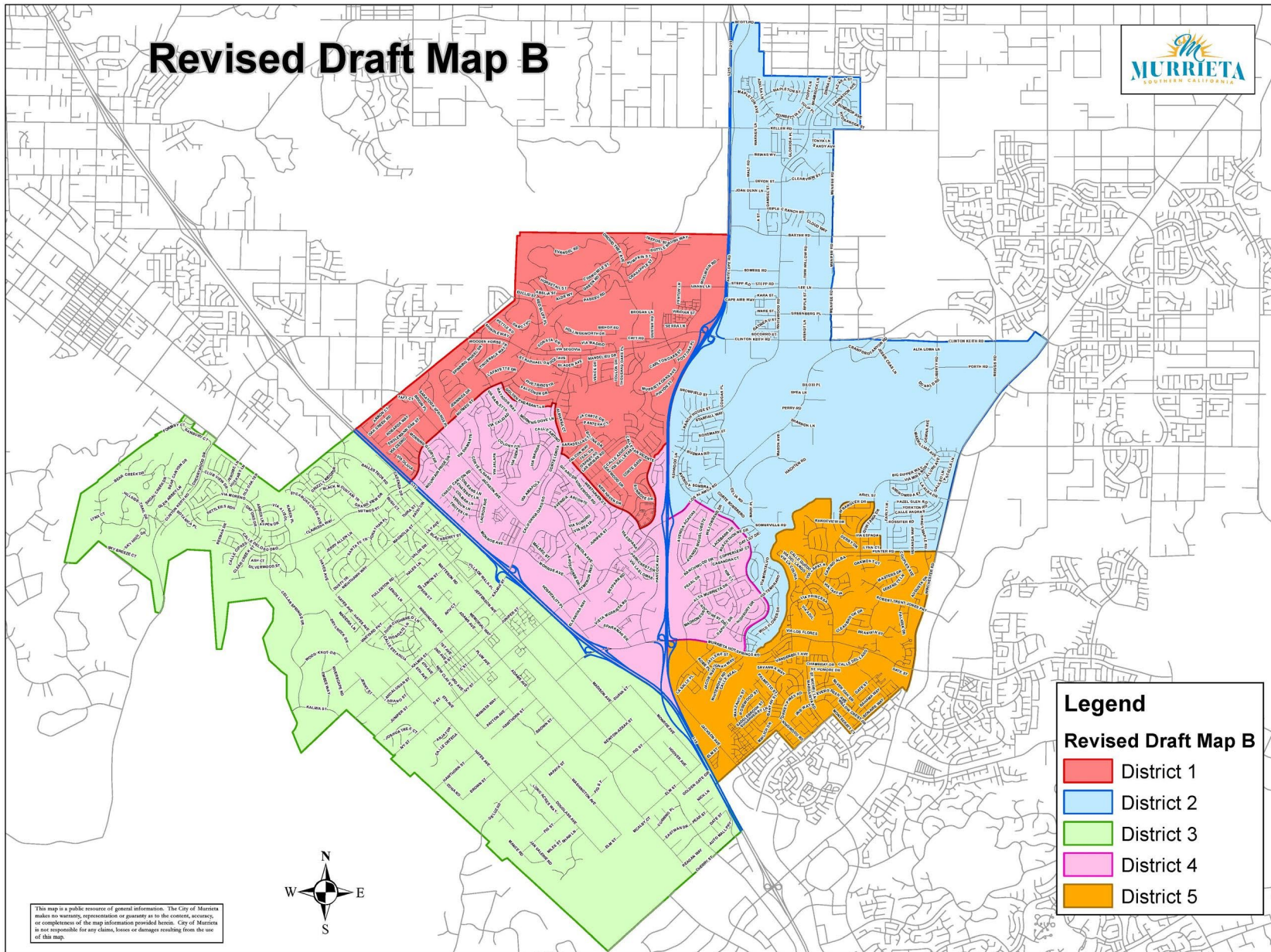
Item No. 10 REDISTRICTING - Adoption of Ordinance

# Next Steps

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**\*\*Deadline to adopt redistricting map April 17, 2022\*\***

- Publication of Ordinance No. 572-22;
- The City Clerk to provide the County of Riverside Registrar of Voters with the updated boundary map for purposes of the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election and subsequent elections; and
- Developing a comprehensive webpage and public outreach.

# Recommendation

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1. Conduct the Public Hearing at a time certain of 6:15 p.m.;
2. Receive public input on Ordinance 572-22;
3. Conduct the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 572-22;  
and
4. If Ordinance No. 572-22 is adopted, direct the City Clerk to provide the County of Riverside Registrar of Voters with the updated boundary map for purposes of the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election and subsequent elections; and fulfill any administrative requirements in accordance with the law.

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# Public Outreach Conducted

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- March 5, 2021: Provided a redistricting update at the City Council Workshop;
- September 8, 2021: Provided a Redistricting update to The Colony at a Town Hall;
- September 13, 27, 28, 2021: Reached out to various Homeowners Associations via phone and email to seek input;
- September 25, 2021: Hosted a Community Kickoff Workshop with Q2 Data & Research;
- October 8, 2021: Mailed out flyers to various neighborhoods regarding the public hearing with ways to participate;

# Public Outreach Conducted [Continued]

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- October 14, 2021: Released an informational video about the redistricting process, specific to Communities of Interest, via the City’s website and social media;
- October 19, 2021: Hosted a public hearing of the redistricting process to receive testimony regarding communities of interest; and
- October 28, 2021: Hosted a public hearing of the redistricting process where Q2 Data & Research conducted a live map drawing session and received direction from City Council to post one draft map “Draft Map B” for public review; and
- November 16, 2021: Hosted a public hearing of the redistricting process where the City Council received public input on the proposed Draft Map B and introduced Ordinance No. 568-21.

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# Public Outreach Conducted

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- December 7, 2021: Held a public hearing of the redistricting process to receive public input and adopt Ordinance 568-21 (not adopted).
- January 31, 2022: Held a public hearing of the redistricting process to receive public input and hold a live map drawing session.
- February 1, 2022: Posted revised Draft Map B for public inspection on the website and at City Hall.
- February 15, 2022: Held a public hearing of the redistricting process to receive public input and introduce Ordinance 572-22.
